### ***DAY TWO REPORT FROM THE SASKATOON EXHIBITION***

Attendance figures for Day Two of the Saskatoon EX saw 31,098 people passing through the gates on Wednesday, August 10, 2011. The two day total sits at 60,258.

Prairieland Park CEO, Mark Regier comments, "Great weather has been a contributing factor in the strong two day attendance numbers we are reporting. The excellent line-up of entertainment will continue over the next 4 days."

Fefe Dobson rocked the grandstand last night, with opening acts Alyssa Reid and Shawn Desman.

Thursday will feature the first night of the Chuckwagon races...drivers from the Canadian Professional Chuckwagon Association (CPCA), as well as the Prince Albert Pony Chuckwagon and Chariot Association (PACCA) will compete for just under \$60,000 in prize money over the next 4 days. All racing will be held at Marquis Downs, beginning at 6:30 tonight.

One of the most popular performances at the EX this year is the Human Cannonball, David "The Bullet" Smith. Performing twice daily, David is hurled 50 miles per hour, reaching a height of 70 feet and a distance of 150 feet before landing into a net.
